To tie in with FCA&C's exhibition of contemporary jewellery/metalwork, ceramics and small scale sculpture, 'Causing Chaos', 3 workshops have been organised relating to the exhibition's content. These are aimed at adults (young and old!) and while they are not masterclasses, will give participants a good flavour of how to use materials in each medium. Each class lasts 2 hours and if you are already a practising artist, will be a great opportunity to try your hand at something new and at a low cost! All materials included in the cost.

- 1 CERAMICS with Fife ceramicist Gavin Burnett**  
**Saturday 18 Sept 2010, 11am - 1pm, cost £5.00**  
Explore slab building with Gavin Burnett, renowned for his hand carved porcelain, to make a vessel incorporating textural surface decoration and using moulds, before covering with slip. You also have the option of Gavin firing your object.
  - 2 JEWELLERY with Dundee jewellers Jane Gowans & Hannah Livingston**  
**Saturday 25 Sept 2010, 11am - 1pm, cost £5.00**  
Join 2 of 'The Collective' jewellers, Jane Gowans & Hannah Livingston, to experiment with jewellery to create wearable objects from a variety of unusual materials, based on the work of jeweller Shari Pierce (featured in the exhibition) whose work often references contemporary social issues.
  - 3 SCULPTURE with Fife sculptor Marion Smith**  
**Saturday 9 Oct 2010, 11am-1pm, cost £5.00**  
Marion Smith, known for her large scale public art sculptures, takes the Causing Chaos exhibition as a starting point to describe and explain the visual language of sculpture, before a practical workshop exploring casting techniques.
