

CAUSING CHAOS kids' workshops (8-12 yrs)

FCA&C @ St Andrews Museum

To tie in with FCA&C's exhibition of contemporary jewellery/metalwork, ceramics and small scale sculpture, 'Causing Chaos', 3 workshops have been organised relating to the exhibition's content, aimed at introducing participants to different materials and how to use them. Each class lasts 2 hours.

- 1 CERAMICS with Fife ceramicist Gavin Burnett
Tuesday 19 Oct 2010, 11am - 1pm, FREE

Explore slab building with Gavin Burnett to make a piece of pottery. Use materials like bubblewrap and corrugated card to press into the surface and have a go at using moulds. You can also cover your pot with coloured slip and Gavin can take it away for firing (you'll get it back!).

- 2 JEWELLERY with Dundee jewellers Jane Gowans & Hannah Livingston
Saturday 23 Oct 2010, 11am - 1pm, FREE

Join 2 of 'The Collective' jewellers, Jane Gowans & Hannah Livingston, to experiment with jewellery making to create wearable objects from a variety of unusual materials. This workshop will be based on the work of jeweller Shari Pierce (featured in the exhibition) whose work is often made from thrown away materials.

- 3 SCULPTURE with Fife sculptor Marion Smith
Thursday 28 Oct 2010, 11am-1pm, FREE

Marion Smith, known for her large scale public art sculptures, takes the Causing Chaos exhibition as a starting point to talk briefly about the variety of materials and shapes that go together to make sculptures, before a practical workshop exploring casting techniques.
