- 2 exhibitions were held in FC museums - Double Visions: contemporary art from Papua New Guinea (also toured to Gateway Galleries, Univ of St A to coincide with major conference), & Causing Chaos (2nd project funded by SAC Craft Development grant; incl successful accompanying events).
- Celebrating Fife 2010 funding allowed a larger Forum to take place & 3 mini residencies linked to the Fife Coastal Path.
- End of first tour & start of 2nd tour of Craft & Info Pods to Fife libraries incl Rosyth, Dalgety Bay, Cowdenbeath, Duloch, and Inverkeithing.

## FCA&C

We have had another busy year, continuing to make links with other Fife based organisations including the Falkland Centre for Stewardship & Fife Coastal & Countryside Trust, as well as our main partner organisations Fife Council Libraries & Museums and the Arts & Theatres Trust Fife.

- 3 exhibitions were held in FC museums - Object as Muse (a Crafts Council touring show), The Marzee Collection & HOTPOT [art, food + people]. More events took place round these and were well attended.
- The Marzee Collection included a special pre-exhibition event of at House of Falkland & was the funded by a crafts development grant from SAC.
- The Craft & Information Pods were launched in St Andrews and started their first tour of libraries in Fife with the work of Spanish jewellery designer Arabel Lebrusan.
- A pilot Fife Coastal Path residency took place in August with Balwearie High School pupils, led by artist Joanna Helfer.
- SAC equalities funding was received, enabling us to appoint a trainee curator (Tonia Lu) for 15 months. She curated HOTPOT.
